View high-definition panoramas from anywhere in the world, including snowy mountain tops and deep sea coral reefs, at 360 Cities, which contains one of the internet's largest collection of uploaded panoramic images.

Global Trek from Scholastic looks like Expedia or Travelocity, but is created for students eager to explore the world from their computer. Students can choose from a list of countries and will be asked to keep a travel journal to write about different topics during their online trip.
