

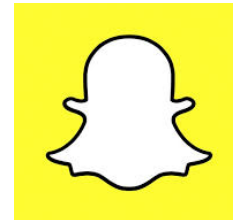

Coherence Map

Mathematics map that shows connections between concepts within and across grades. Allows you to trace a standard back through its pre-requisites in order to design instruction that scaffolds grade-level standards. full face makeup airbrush foundation

Text-Dependent Questions

Tools to help write and evaluate text-dependent questions, including a checklist for evaluating and templates and guides for creating. Includes lessons and writing samples with text-dependent questions and tasks.

Foundational Skills

Resources and protocols to support K-2 students to build critical early literacy skills. Includes best practices to support the explicit teaching of foundational skills such as print concepts, phonological awareness, phonics and word recognition and fluency.

Text Sets

Book sets that support all learners, especially those with background knowledge or vocabulary needs through a volume of reading on science, social studies, and other high interest topics. Lessons have been developed with an emphasis on building knowledge and academic vocabulary .
